No entry without permission, strict checking at the entrance.

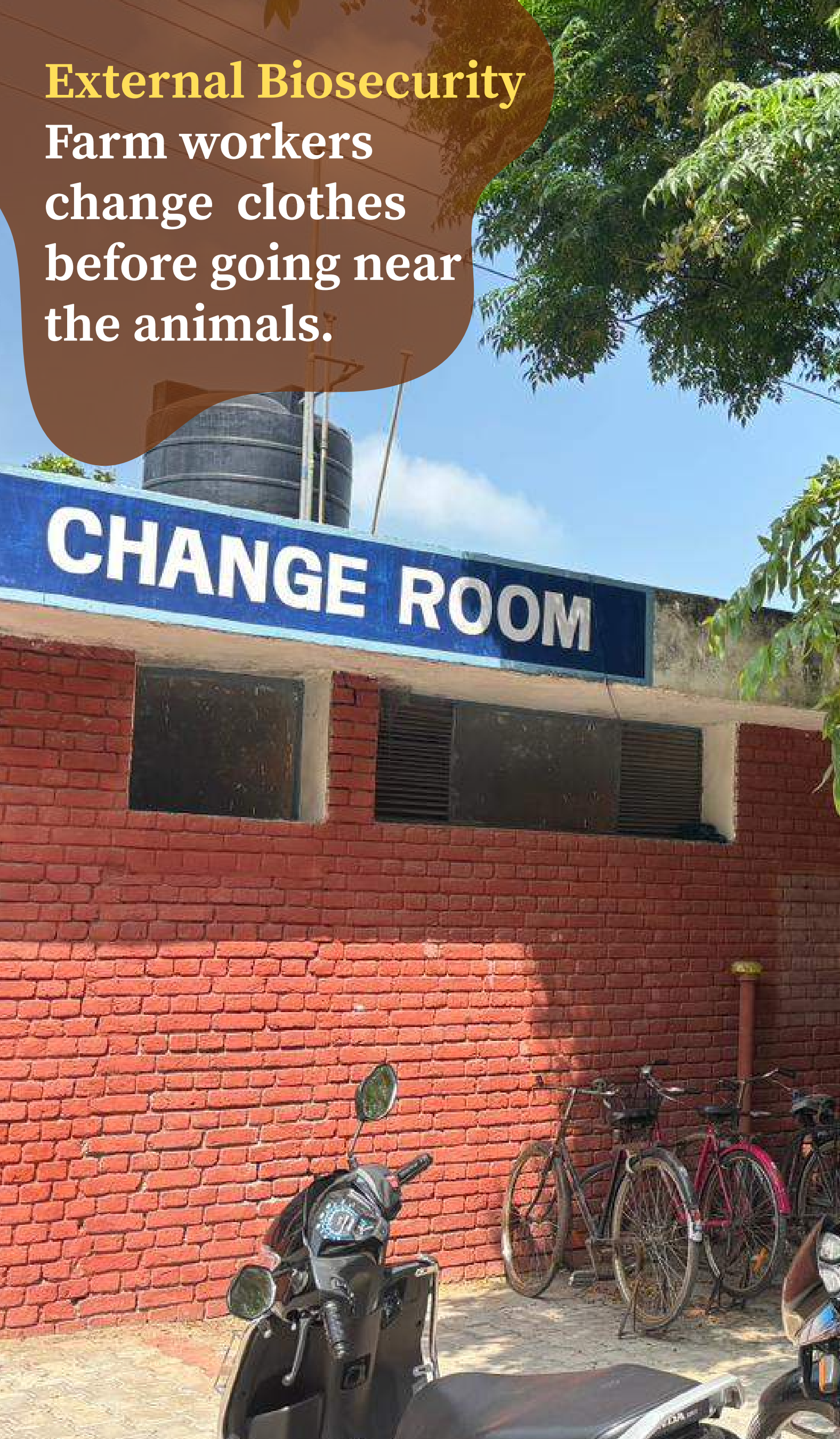


External Biosecurity

External Biosecurity

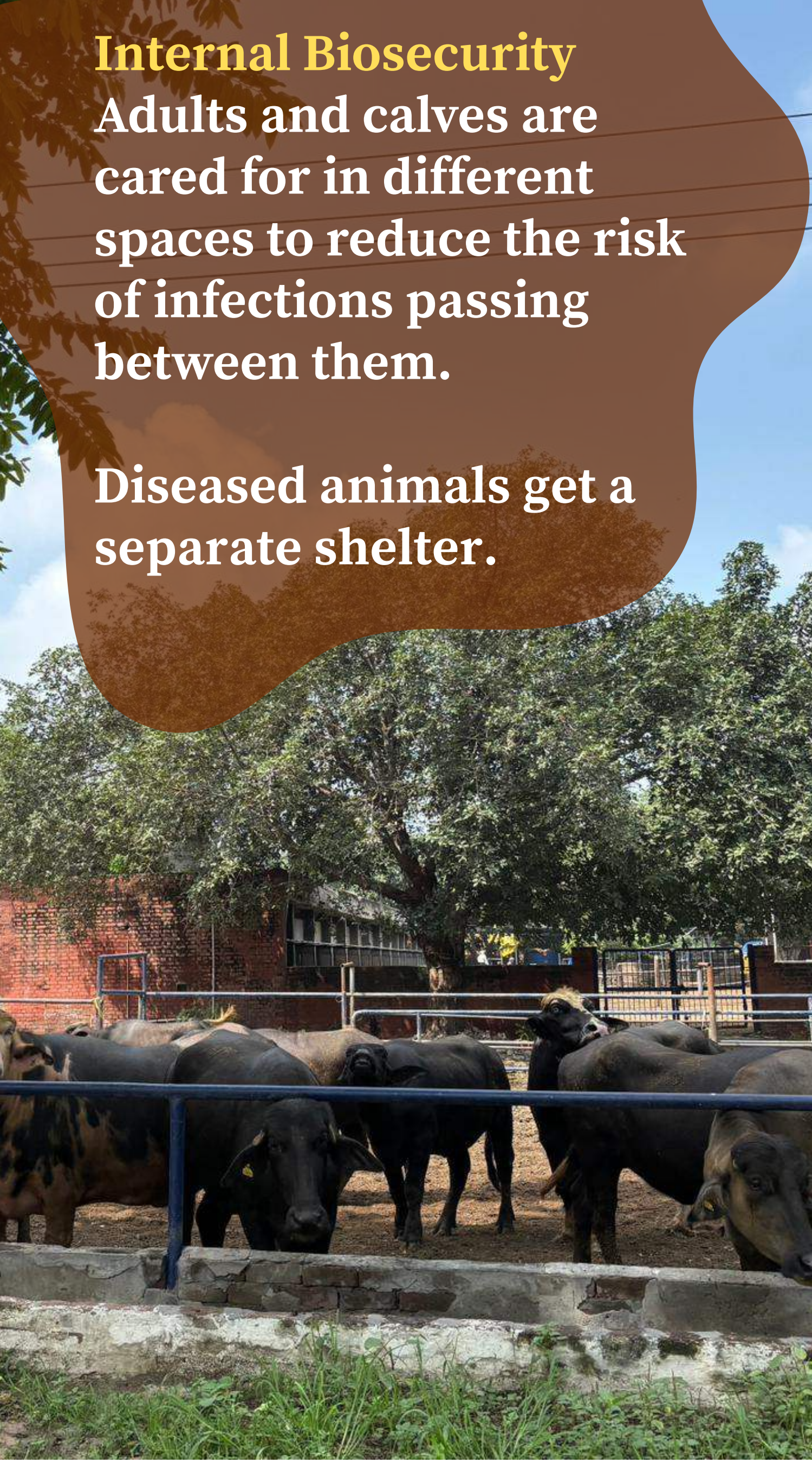
Farm workers

the animals.



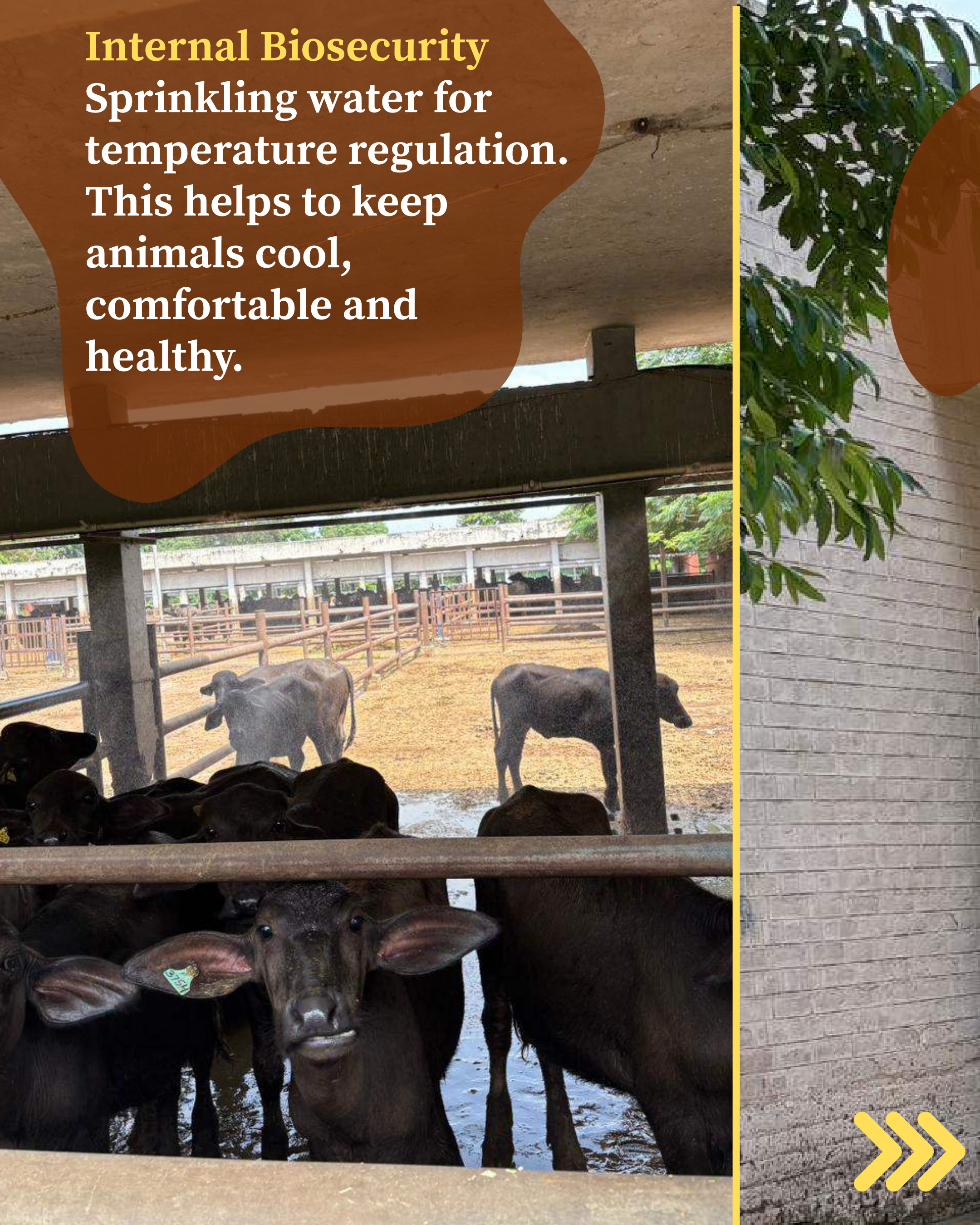
Internal Biosecurity

Adults and calves are cared for in different spaces to reduce the risk of infections passing between them.

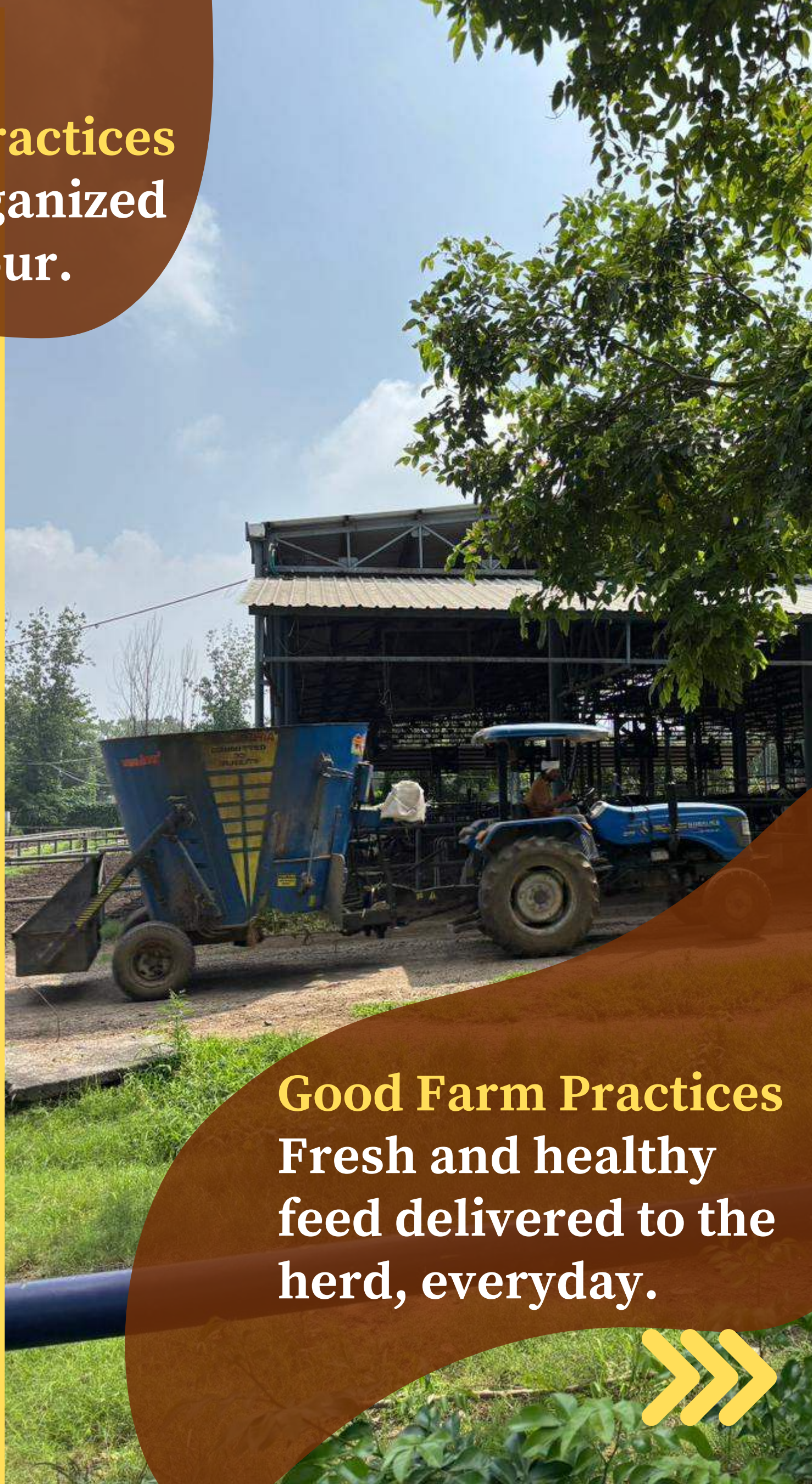
Diseased animals get a separate shelter.
